## Global CNS Week

### Advancing Technology for Safer, Smarter Air Navigation

**ICAO Air Navigation World (ANW) 2026 – Communications, Navigation, Surveillance, and Spectrum Symposium (CNSS)** will be held in **Kotor, Montenegro, from 12 to 15 October 2026.**

This ICAO event will be hosted by **IFATSEA** and will take place at the **Hyatt Regency Kotor Bay Resort.**

This event will bring together the global aviation community to discuss the future of air navigation, CNS innovation, spectrum protection, digital transformation, and next-generation operational concepts.

The official State Letter has been circulated to ICAO Member States and is available in all six ICAO languages.

## Expected audience

The event is expected to gather **350+ participants from around the world**, including representatives of:

- civil aviation authorities;
- air navigation service providers;
- airports and airlines;
- regulatory bodies;
- international aviation organizations;
- leading aviation industry companies;
- subject-matter experts and senior ICAO officials.

## Why partner with this event?

This is the first global ICAO CNSS event in the history of the organization, giving partners the opportunity not only to support this event, but also to become part of a milestone moment in aviation history in the CNS and spectrum domain.

ICAO events of this level are rarely hosted in Europe. This makes the CNSS Symposium in Montenegro a unique opportunity for companies and organizations to strengthen their visibility in front of a highly relevant international aviation audience.



Partners will have the opportunity to position their brand, connect with key decision-makers, and engage with stakeholders shaping the future of air navigation and aviation technology.

Although the event is focused on CNS and Spectrum, it will be relevant for the wider aviation ecosystem, including airports, airlines, technology providers, telecom operators, infrastructure companies, service providers, and organizations supporting aviation operations.
